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QUICK FACTS

- Myeloproliferative neoplasms (MPNs) are a closely related group of progressive blood cancers in which the bone marrow typically overproduces one of the mature blood elements.
- There are three types of MPNs: essential thrombocythemia (ET), polycythemia vera (PV), and myelofibrosis (MF).
- MPNs can occur at any age but are most common among middle age and older adults.
- As a rare and incurable cancer, currently, effective symptom management is the best way for patients to preserve quality of life while living with the disease.
